Re: 2026 Summer Maintenance & Preparedness

Now that we are in the warmer summer months, it is important to prepare your buildings for the weather and have a plan in place in the event of severe weather. Here are some suggestions to help your Parish/School/Agency prepare and contact information in case of a property loss.

- Remove debris from your gutters and downspouts to prevent water accumulation.
- Clear debris from storm drains, catch basins, and culverts to prevent water accumulation.
- Ensure downspouts and other water runoff is directed away from the foundation of the building(s).
- Cut down and/or trim trees that overhang or are growing towards buildings.
- Ensure sensitive electronics (computers, copiers, AV equipment, etc.) are plugged into a reliable surge protector suitable for the equipment.
- Get HVAC systems checked to ensure your system is well maintained.
- Perform routine maintenance on your water heater and examine for leaks, check the interior of building for water leaks. Consider adding a water leak detection device to your buildings.
- Have a certified, licensed, and insured pest control professional inspect all buildings.
- Have a certified, licensed, and insured termite control professional inspect all buildings.
- Ensure smoke detectors are working properly and get familiar with your fire extinguishers to be prepared for kitchen or grill fires.
- Have an emergency plan in place in the event your building is not inhabitable due to severe property loss.
- Document your property and belongings by taking pictures of the interior including contents and exterior in case you have a future claim.

Please promptly report all claims. In the case of a property loss necessitating external vendor assistance for remediation (e.g. water or fire damage), kindly reach out to me directly on my cell phone at 504-491-3126, especially after hours. This ensures swift action guaranteeing adherence to an agreed-upon fee schedule, selecting vendors with suitable insurance coverage, and protecting the building(s) from further damage after a loss. Your quick notification enables us to secure immediate services and maintain quality standards.
